Review and Amend By-laws

Tom Kneafsey made a motion to form a subcommittee to review and update our bylaws. Joanna Vernetti seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Tom Kneafsey, Joanna Vernetti, Heather Boylston, Rebecca Hutchinson to serve on subcommittee.

Time-Sensitive Addition to Agenda:

Tom Kneafsey motioned that the Board agree the need to vote on the City's CPI increase (which arrived at the BID after this meeting's agenda was posted) was time sensitive and needed to be voted on at today's meeting; Mary Frances Fenady seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Tom Kneafsey motioned to approve the City's annual CPI increase of 2.7%, allowing for property owner assessments to be adjusted upwards by 2.7%. Gina St. Aubin seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
